We ask that you carefully read this user manual before using the Adam Trip Chair. The information in this manual is essential for the proper functioning and maintenance of your chair, as well as for preventing potential injuries due to incorrect use.

Non-original modifications can compromise the safety of your chair.

Intended Use

The use of the Adam Trip Chair must align with the intended purpose and safety instructions. If there are any uncertainties, please contact us or your dealer/supplier.

This device is designed to function as a trip/work chair and is intended primarily as an aid in private settings. The purpose of this chair is to simplify the user's life with its height adjustment functionality, low rolling resistance wheels, and ergonomic design.

User Assessment

This device is intended for users who meet the following recommendations:

- The user's weight does not exceed 135 kg.
- The user's height is at least 120 cm.
- The user has sufficient functionality in their feet/legs to move independently.

Lifespan of the Device

The lifespan of this device is at least ten (10) years. However, depending on the intensity of use and charging intervals, the lifespan of the battery pack and wheels may be shorter.

This lifespan is calculated assuming preventive maintenance is carried out as described in this manual.

Depending on wear and tear, some components such as batteries, wheels, and upholstery parts may need to be replaced during the device's lifespan.



Safety Instructions

Below are some essential instructions for the safe use of your device.

WARNING

Ensure that the chair is always braked when getting in and out. This prevents possible injuries.

WARNING

When sitting in the chair and wanting to move, make sure the armrests are raised and locked.

WARNING

Never brake the chair on a slope and lean backward. Otherwise, you risk the chair tipping over.

CAUTION

This device is for indoor use. Using this device outdoors may cause permanent damage to the wheels and electrical components.

CAUTION

Never use sharp objects near your device. This can cause damage.

CAUTION

Never perform work on the Adam Trip Chair if you do not have the necessary knowledge or authorization.



Preparations

Before using your device, take the following preparations into account.

First Use

- 1. Perform a visual inspection to check for any transport damage to your Adam.
- 2. Dispose of the packaging according to applicable regulations.
- 3. Verify that all parts have been delivered. You can compare this with the "Description of Supplied Parts" list in this user manual.
- 4. Read this user manual carefully.
- 5. Unpack the battery charger and place it in an easily memorable location.
- 6. Charge your Adam for at least 8 hours.
- 7. Test all functions as explained in the Preventive Maintenance Schedule (PMS).
- 8. Store this user manual in an easily accessible location.

Before Each Use

1. Check the wheels and the parking brake.



Function Description

Mechanical Height Adjustment:

Deze instelling is enkel voorzien om de Adam aan uw lichaamslengte aan te passen en dient door uw dealer/verstrekker bij het eerste gebruik ingesteld te worden.

- 1. The height of the chair can be manually adjusted to fit the user's body height.
- 2. To adjust, loosen the M10 bolt (SW 17).
- 3. Set the column to the desired height while ensuring the seat remains level.
- 4. Retighten the bolt with a maximum torque of 90NM.

Electrical Height Adjustment:

The Adam Trip Chair is electrically height adjustable.
Use the control under the armrest to raise or lower the chair.

Press the button in the direction of the upward arrow to raise the chair. Press the button in the direction of the downward arrow to lower the chair.

The control can be positioned on either the left or right side upon request.

An additional handheld control is available as an optional extra.





Parking brake operation:

A lever was attached to the chair to operate the parking brake. If the lever is in forward position, the chair can be moved. When the lever is in backward position, the rear wheels are entirely blocked and you can safely step on or off.

In consultation with your dealer/provider this lever can be positioned on the left or right hand side.





Function Description

Angle adjustment backrest:

- Press the lever below the backrest down
- Put the backrest in the correct position and put the lever up again
- The backrest is now locked in the new position



Height adjustment backrest:

- Unscrew the round knob counter clockwise
- Slide the back to the desired height
- Subsequently tighten the round knob turning it clockwise



Width adjustment armrests:

The width between the armrests can be adjusted by unscrewing the Allen bolts at the bottom of the seat.

Afterwards you can adjust the width.

Once the desired width has been reached, you must retighten the Allen bolts.



Height adjustment armrests:

- The height of the armrests can be adjusted by pulling the handle on the side upwards.
- Then set the armrests to the desired height and release the handle.





Function Description

Folding away the armrests:

armrests of the Adam can also be folded away to be able to easily transfer sideways. To do this, pull up the entire armrest and fold it backwards.





Stepping onto and off your Adam working chair

Make sure that the parking brake is always on before you step onto or off your triple chair, as set out on page 12 of this manual.

If you want to step onto the triple chair from a bed or a sofa, you can fold the armrests backwards to transfer sideways. How to fold away the armrests is described on the previous page.

After you are seated, you can place back the armrest. This will automatically go back to locked position.

In order to prevent damage to your Adam triple chair, use only MSP Medical Chemicals products.



Step-by-step plan Cleaning and Disinfection

Your Adam Triple chair is easy to maintain by use of this step-by-step plan. When you meticulously follow this procedure, the chair will always be in optimal hygienic condition.

Step 1 – Removal or visual pollution

- Put on gloves before you start
- Remove dust and any dirt from the Adam by filling a spray flacon with water and spray the upholstery and frame. Then take a soft brush and remove any dirt. Dry it with a cleaning cloth
- Check if there is any dirt around the wheels (such as hairs or accumulated dust) and remove this manually

Step 2 – Usage of all-purpose cleaner

- Also put on the safety glasses (goggles) now
- Take the MSP Medical Chemicals all-purpose cleaner in spray flacon and spray the chair entirely, with the exception of the upholstery
- Use the (long) soft brush and thoroughly brush the entire chair. A cleaning cloth can also be used
- Use a new cleaning cloth and dampen it with water. Remove any cleaning residue. Optionally a spray flacon with water and dry cloth can be used to remove the residues
- Repeat step above until the chair is free from cleaning residue. The cloth should be frequently scoured in water

Step 3 – Use of disinfectant

- Use the MSP Medical Chemicals disinfectant in spray flacon and spray the chair entirely, with the exception of the upholstery
- Use the (long) soft brush and thoroughly brush the entire chair. A cleaning cloth can also be used
- Use a new cleaning cloth and dampen it with water. Remove any disinfection residue.
 Optionally a spray flacon with water and dry cloth can be used to remove the residues.
- Repeat step above until the chair is free from disinfection residue. The cloth should be frequently scoured in water.
- Now allow the entire chair to dry.

Step 4 – Cleaning up

Your Adam triple chair is once again ready for use. All materials used must be disposed of/reused in accordance with the applicable recycling standards.



Instructions how to handle the batteries

WARNING

In order to avoid injury, the battery should NEVER be:

- Crushed
- Punctured
- Opened
- Disassembled

If the casing of the battery is opening up and the content comes into contact with your skin and/or clothes, the immediately rinse with abundant water.

If the content of the battery pack comes into contact with your eyes, the immediately rinse thoroughly with abundant water and seek medical attention.

Inhaling of the content may lead to irritation of the airways. Move to the outside air and seek medical attention.

REMARK

To prevent overheating and risk of explosion, never expose the battery pack to fire or extreme heat sources.

Storage

If you are not going to use your Adam Triple chair for a longer period of time, observe the following:

- The batteries will automatically slowly discharge if they are not being used. We recommend to charge the batteries at least every 6 months, using the included charger, to help lengthen the lifespan
- If the Adam triple chair is not in use, the ambient temperature should be between 0°C and +30°C
- For optimal performance, never expose the batteries to temperatures higher than +50°C



Charging the Adam

Before use, check the battery charger for damage.

Charge your Adam only using the included battery charger (MSP-C-MP-00100). The usage of a non-original charger may lead to a reduced lifespan of your batteries and/or damage to the electronics.

The included battery charger will regulate itself fully automatically and always ensures the most ideal charging cycle. Please find below the correct step-by-step plan for charging your chair:

- First connect the charger with the main electricity by plugging it into a socket outlet.
- Then plug the charging cable into the charging connection under the armrest (fig. 1). The indication LED will now turn red.
- When charging is completed, the indication LED on the battery charger will turn green. You can now remove the charging cable from the charger connection and disconnect the battery charger from the mains. Store the battery charger in a place that you can easily remember.



With a completely charged battery pack, the Adam can be lifted and lowered approximately 25 times, when an average user weight is being applied. Should the batteries run low, then the electronics will automatically shut down, upon which you will need to charge the chair again, in accordance with abovementioned procedure.

The batteries are based on SLA-technology, due to which they are gas and fluid resistant. This makes it possible to charge at any location and no specific regulations are required.

In practice it may be useful to charge the chair every night, in case of daily use.

If you are not going to use the chair for a longer period of time, then you should set the switch at the back of the chair to 0 (zero) or leave the charger connected. The charger will then serve as a trickle charger and keep the batteries in good condition. This will prevent damage to the battery pack.

For a maximum lifespan we recommend that you charge the battery pack at regular intervals. For example every night, or every other day, depending on the intensity of use.

End of lifespan

If you notice that the Adam can be used for increasingly shorter periods of time, then the batteries require replacement. Contact your dealer/provider or us to order a new battery pack.

The old batteries must be disposed of in accordance with the applicable regulations or can be returned to us.



Preventative Maintenance Schedule (POS)

Unfortunately your Adam triple chair will be subject to wear. If you carry out the activities below at the indicated intervals, you can limit this wear to a minimum and make optimal use of the lifespan.

Never carry out activities on the Adam triple chair when you do not have the required knowledge or authorisations.



Annual Inspection

Apart from the preventive maintenance, the proper and safe functioning of the Adam triple chair requires annual inspection.

This must be carried out by the technical service of MSP or your dealer/provider.

This inspection must at least contain the following checks:

Mechanical:

- Check whether the frame and lifting mechanism show (hair)crack indications
- Check all welding and bolt connections
- Check on straightness
- Check on other damage due to wear or external impact
- Check on the actuation and wheels
- Check on all slack and adjustments
- Check the high/low spindle and spindle nut

Electrical:

- Check wiring for cable breaks
- Check all plug connections
- Check the electrical (safety) functions
- Check the control software
- Check the battery capacity
- Check the battery charger

Finally, a grounding/insulation test on the battery pack and the battery charger must be performed!



Unrecommended usage

- Do not use the Adam triple chair for transport of animals and goods.
- Do not use the Adam triple chair as a towing, pushing or hoisting tool for any application whatsoever.
- Po not use the Adam triple chair when it has a defect or when you suspect it has a defect.
- The Adam triple chair is equipped with a very powerful lifting system, therefore never allow children to play with the triple chair.

Solving Problems

Below you can find a number of problems that may occur, as well as the related solution for these problems.
